

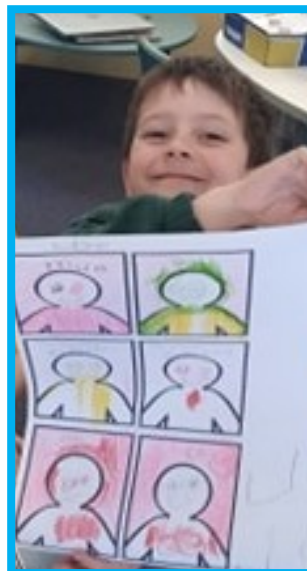

Maliyan News

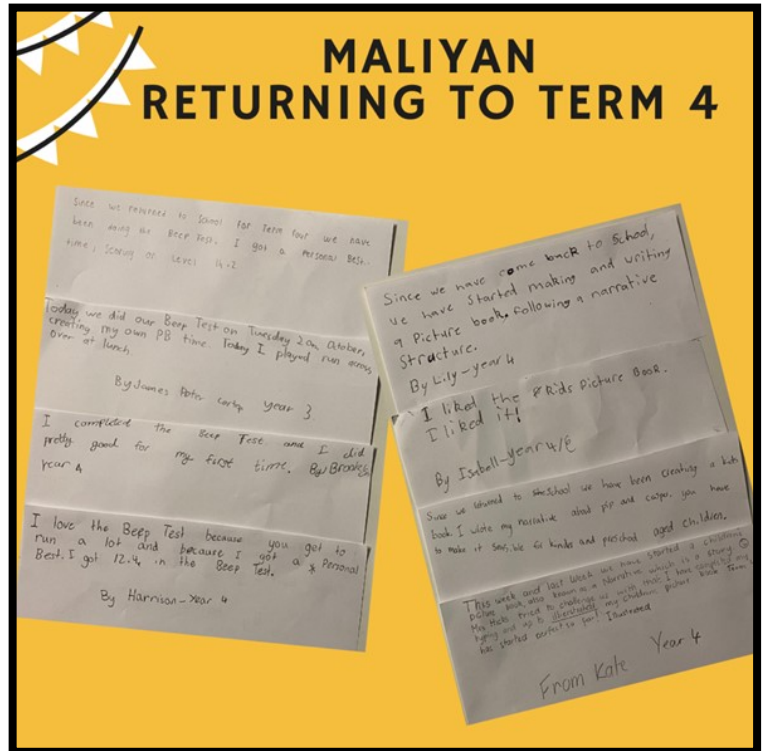
Welcome back to Term 4. Students have dived straight back into learning activities, demonstrating all the skills and understanding they have obtained throughout the year.
